Where: Monk Fryston Community Centre

Pay: £9.50 per hour

Hours:3 hours per a week – 1.5 hours of face to face delivery and 1.5hour of planning/preparation
(Term time only – 41 weeks through the year: Quarter 1 (Jan – March) – 12 sessions, Quarter 2 (April – June) – 10 sessions, Quarter 3 (July – Sept) – 7 sessions, Quarter 4 (Oct – Dec) –12 sessions)

The Youth Leaders will provide 1 session per a week (term time only) for young people in years 3-6 in Monk Fryston Community Centre. Sessions will be short or long term projects based on a variety of popular youth activities with a focus on community i.e. cookery, arts, music, games, dance, youth forum, fundraising.

North Yorkshire Youth (NYY), a local youth association will help sustain the club and work closely with the appointed staff as well as seek to recruit volunteers to assist in the projects.

Note - The successful candidates will need to be self-employed.

 - Support volunteers keen to be involved
- Keep updated with safeguarding, health and safety and other key policies

 - Be a role model and advocate for young people
- Support young people to be seen in a positive way in their communities
- Enable young people to give back to their community and link in with local groups
