What you said we did well

The school provides a safe environment for my child

100% of respondents feel that the school encourages their child to treat others with respect and dignity (well above other schools nationally)

77% pupils like the way they are



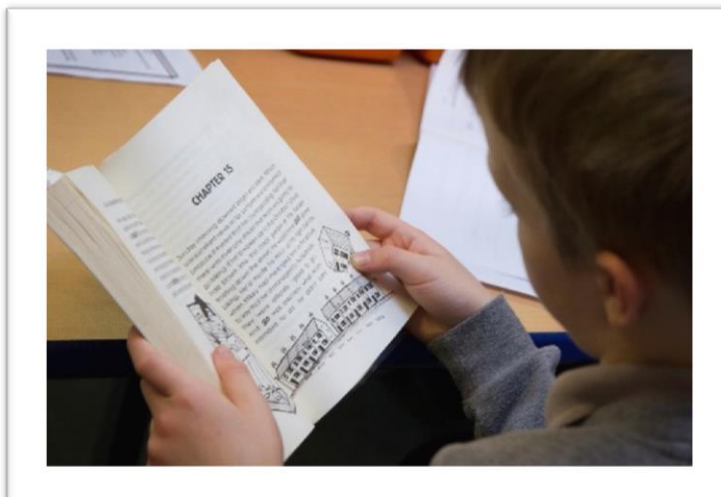
What we'll do next
