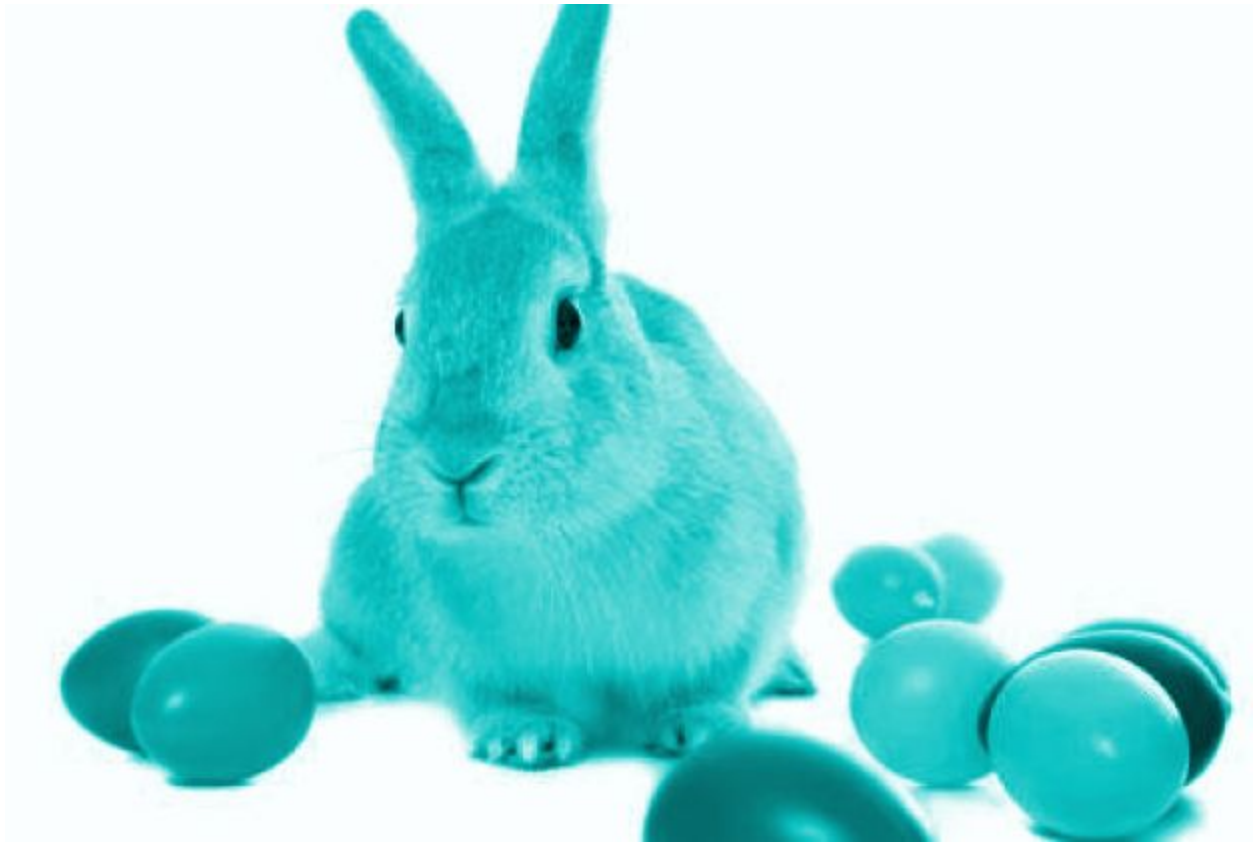

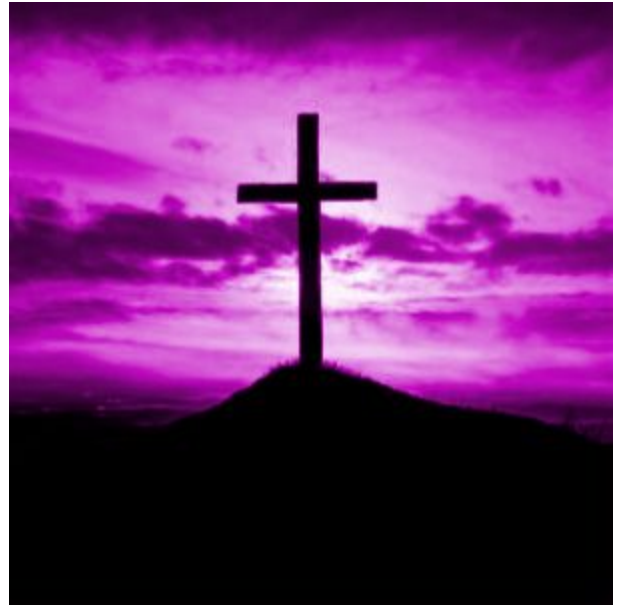

Recipes

Chocolate chip buns

Ingredients

- 100g of unsalted butter
- 100g of caster sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 100g of self-raising flour
- 100g of chocolate chips
- Half a tbs of vanilla essence
- 24 chocolate mini eggs
- Icing sugar for topping
- Cupcake cases

Method

- 1) Preheat the oven to 190oc/gas mark 5. Prepare your cupcake tray with the cases needed.
- 2) Put the butter in with the caster sugar and use an electric whisk to beat until light and fluffy.
- 3) Slowly whisk in the eggs a bit at a time so that they don't curdle. Once fully whisked add the vanilla essence.
- 4) Sift the flour into the mixture and fold it using a spatula so as to get all of the flour mixed. Once consistent, add the chocolate chips and fold them in as well.
- 5) Get a spoon and spoon in the mixture into the bun cases.
- 6) When the cakes have be cooked add the chocolate mini eggs on top.
