We are looking for two General Teaching Assistants who will each be working 15 hours over 5 mornings each week. We are seeking caring, hardworking and enthusiastic individuals to join our committed staff team who have high aspirations both for themselves and our children, have a passion for learning, are proactive and dependable and have strong interpersonal skills and a positive outlook. In return we can offer you the opportunity to make a real difference to children's learning and to be part of a happy and effective staff team.

Post 1

We have the opportunity for a GTA to work within our Nursery to support a child in their play, peer relationships and understanding of the themes covered. They will need to take responsibility for the speech therapy for this child and developing their understanding and use of language and communication in our setting. This post would suit a candidate who has a competent understanding of working with pupils with special needs. The hours of work will be 08.30 - 11.30 am, 5 mornings a week.

Post 2

We have the opportunity for a GTA to work across our Nursery and Reception classes. Initially the role will involve working in Nursery for two mornings each week and Reception for three mornings each week. The work in Nursery will be to support a child with medical needs, specifically Recessive Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa (EB), a physical skin condition that needs regular medical attention throughout the session. A first aid qualification is not essential (additional training will be provided), but the successful candidate must feel comfortable working with blood, blisters, and administering dressings. The post would suit someone who has experience of working with a child with medical needs, or someone who has a medical background. The role will also involve supporting the child build their peer relationships and be a support to them when dealing with issues that arise during the session, as well as assessing risk and acting accordingly. The role in Reception will be to work with the class teacher to support teaching and learning by working with individuals or small groups of pupils under the direction of the teaching staff. The hours of work will be 08.45 -11.45 am, 5 mornings a week.
